COMPETITION RULES



1. Entrants must be 16 years of age or under on March 10th 2019.
2. Competitors must be Irish citizens.
3. All competition entries must be made online and be accompanied by:
 - a.) A completed entry form (available on www.thegalwaydrumshow.com) signed by a parent or guardian. This should be sent by email to: info@thegalwaydrumshow.com
 - b.) A link to an online video (YouTube/Facebook etc.) (no editing accepted) of the entrant, performing for two minutes, on an acoustic kit, with no other musicians or live musical accompaniment. The entrants' face must be clearly visible on the video.
4. Incomplete entry forms, will be considered invalid.
5. Documents supplied to The Galway Drum Show will not be returned to the applicant.
6. All correspondence with the finalists will be by email. Finalists must ensure that they have access to an operational email address to receive instructions from the event organisers.
7. The deadline for entries is 11.59pm Wednesday 20th February
8. Breaking any of the rules outlined in this document will disqualify a Finalist.
9. Each Finalist must register on the day of the finals at the venue and time stated.
10. Finalists will not be permitted to keep mobile phones with video/sound recording capabilities with them once registered, until the winner is announced.
11. Copies of either a Birth Certificate with photo ID or a Passport are only acceptable as proof of age.
12. The organisers will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by the Finalists whatsoever.
13. The running order for the finals will be determined by a draw in the presence of the Finalists on the day of the finals.
14. Finalists will be required to play a two minute solo, they will then have to play along to a piece of music supplied approximately 2 weeks prior to the finals. A reasonable allowance is made for finalists who finish slightly before or the after the permitted two minutes. Finalists who extend their solo beyond this may lose points.
15. Finalists will be marked out of 10 on six competencies.
16. A five piece drum kit, hi-hats, 2 crash cymbals, a ride cymbal, hardware and stool will be supplied by the organisers. Finalists may only use their own bass drum pedal (single or double) and sticks.
17. The decision of the judges is final.
18. The winner will receive a Cambridge Drum Company custom made snare drum rewarding their achievement.
19. By entering the competition, all entrants and their parents / guardians agree to the finalists' name and image being used in any promotional material for the Irish Young Drummer of the Year competition, galwaydrumshow.com or the competition sponsors for this or any future years.
20. By entering the competition, competitors agree that The Galway Drum Show, the Irish Young Drummer of the Year competition, its sponsors and all its contributors, agents, volunteers or anyone else involved with the competition hereby disclaim and exclude to the greatest extent permitted by law all liability for any loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever incurred by any competitor their family, friends, or supporters or anyone representing a competitor or competitors including any consequential, special, secondary or indirect loss or damage or any damage to name, brand, goodwill or profits whether arising in tort, contract or otherwise, and arising out of or in relation to or in connection with the Irish Young Drummer of the Year competition.
